### **Mission and Project Summary:**

The aim of this project is to purchase tests to measure Hemoglobin A1c to help patients control their Type 1 Diabetes Mellitus. With these test, caretakers can determine the metabolic control of the patients which is useful for education and therapeutic adjustments. Since it only pricks the finger instead of an intensive blood test, it allows immediate, simple and fast results. This is helpful to avoid the “fear” and anxiety that many children and parents feel with full blood draws.

### **Mission and Project Summary:**

This project aims to build a kitchen in the very proximity of a school in order to facilitate the appropriate feeding of the children attending this school and to prevent food contamination. The cooking for these children is currently done at a compound 2 km away of the school, meaning that the children have to travel 4km daily (school- food compound and back) in order to have their food.

This organization is currently providing a meal once a day for 70 children, ages 3 to 7. Many parents send their children to school because of the food service, especially the girls, which tend to have high rates absenteeism. The organization has started with 56 children and the attendance continues to increase, reaching nowadays 90 children.

The children do not pay for the training courses, the charity provides them through donations.

### **Mission and Project Summary:**

The aim of this project is to provide more than 30 children with disabilities an opportunity to receive Halotherapy by building an artificial "Salt cave." About half of the children that receive rehabilitation in our Center, in addition to their severe health diagnoses, have other comorbidities like respiratory diseases (asthma, bronchitis, allergies) and different skin pathologies (dermatitis, eczema, skin infections) which can be eased and treated by receiving Halotherapy. There is no Halotherapy anywhere near our location and families and children are forced to travel long distances to receive this therapy. The funding from this project would give the opportunity to provide support to children with special needs near their home and to increase their quality of life.

The project's main goal is to emancipate them from social determinism by improving their level of education, intellectual potential and health while socializing them through sport.

The module will involve also representatives of state and/or local authorities, international partners, including embassies and international organizations, local businesses, media and other stakeholders in solving gender representation problem in technical fields in the country.

### **Mission and Project Summary:**

The project includes professional assistance to families whose children suffer from severe spinal muscular atrophy and Duchenne muscular dystrophy. Financial coverage will help parents through externally cooperating therapists who have long-term experience with children with these diagnoses, especially in the initial phase when parents need to learn how to care for such a disabled child. It also includes the education of the extended family of such a disabled child in the form of therapeutic family tables to become acquainted with the issues associated with childcare in order to reduce the fear of providing care by the extended family. The funds will further provide therapeutic stays of families with such a sick child (rehabilitation, swimming, psychotherapy, exercise, relaxation), a portable device for loan to sick children for Snoozelen light therapy, a Pantera Micro mechanical wheelchair for loan to sick children, and a Bobath therapeutic cylinder with a diameter of 20 centimeters and 25 centimeters for loan to sick children.

This is the basis for corrections in the therapeutical, recreational, and competitive levels. For instance, people with spinal cord injuries do not feel where their legs are, and in the time of swimming, they cannot see what they are doing. In the period of one year, the charity is planning to develop therapeutic parafreediving to the recreational and competitive level in the area of static and dynamic Apnea. They are planning to train 30 parafreedivers and 20 assistants, and organize competitions where in order to get maximum inclusion also non-handicapped free-divers will attend.

They are also used in the Newborn Department and in the naso/oro-tracheal intubation instruction procedure by Pediatric Emergency Unit's personnel and family doctor's cabinets personnel. These air/oxygen mixers are used for controlled oxygen delivery for newborns and children after the latest disease management and resuscitation guidelines; – pulseoxymeters are used for the improvement of bed-side emergency patient monitoring in the two departments and Birthing Room.
