Mission and Project Summary:

The aim of this project is to support 130 children between the ages of 6 and 17 living in extreme poverty, by serving them three meals a day, for a year. These young people are among the vulnerable populations who live or study in the historic centre of Quito, Ecuador. In their homes, most of them suffer from physical and psychological abuse, which harms children and youth in their school development. In addition to meals, the project will provide young people support with homework, company, and personalized school follow-up. Feeding them on a regular basis will not only help to decrease the chance of malnutrition but will also to give them the opportunity to develop intellectually.

Target and number of beneficiaries: 130 children.

The aim of this project is to support and improve the morale of children members of Spina Bifida, along with their parents. Mission and Project Summary:

The aim of this project is organizing cultural and art classes, as well as excursions aimed at introducing Polish culture and history, and teaching about Polish regions. The project will organize recitations and singing competitions. It will coordinate art workshops aimed to develop manual skills and teach about various art techniques. It will promote participation in historical competitions and patriotic celebrations organized by Polish institutions. It will organize trips to memorials related to Polish history and culture, such as cemeteries, cultural centres, and exhibitions. It will promote Polish art in Belgium and will support activities in the field of historical education aimed at shaping patriotic attitudes among children and adolescents. It will help develop a social awareness with a long-term impact and will benefit as many people as possible.

Target and number of beneficiaries: 150 children.
